Anatomy & Physiology

- Why would anyone but clinicians need this training?

Increased specificity...

- Laterality
- Dominant vs. non-dominant
- Intent (self-harm, assault, error)
- Source (identify perpetrator)
- Severity (mild, moderate, severe)

...Requires Wider Understanding

- Body site (Bone vs. Joint, quadrants)
- Type (breech vs. transverse lie presentation)

Pharyngitis in ICD-10

Codeset

- Convert a code
- Same approach as ICD-9
 - Index first **always**
 - *Then* review the code(s)

Code Format

- Alpha/Num
 - Except “U”
 - Includes zeros
- Place holder “X”

ICD-10 Partner Features

- Version 6.19
 - Additional tted Table
 - ICD-10 Diagnoses (coming soon)

ICD-10 EHR Features

- Transition to SNOMED

ICD-10 FAQ

- What can I do now?
 - Ask your vendors about their readiness
 - PCC's plans on Pedsource

What can we do now?

- Add ICD-10 to all meeting agendas throughout 2014
- Cashflow contingencies
 - Get \$\$\$ - recommend 6 mos of payables in the bank (loan(s) if nec)
- Put off unnecessary spending
