- ICD-9 Acute
 - 381.00 Acute *nonsuppurative* otitis media,
 unspecified
 - 381.01 Acute *serous* otitis media
 - 381.02 Acute *mucoid* otitis media
 - 381.03 Acute *sanguinous* otitis media
 - 381.04 Acute *allergic serous* otitis media
 - 381.05 Acute *allergic mucoid* otitis media
 - 381.06 Acute allergic sanguinous otitis media



- ICD-9 Acute (cont'd)
 - 382.00 Acute suppurative otitis media *without* spontaneous rupture of eardrum
 - 382.01 Acute suppurative otitis media with spontaneous rupture of eardrum
 - 382.02 Acute suppurative otitis media in diseases classified elsewhere



- ICD-9 Chronic
 - 381.10 Chronic serous otitis media, simple or unspecified
 - 381.19 Other chronic serous otitis media
 - 381.20 Chronic mucoid otitis media, simple or unspecified
 - 381.29 Other chronic mucoid otitis media



- ICD-9 Chronic (cont'd)
 - 381.3 Other and unspecified chronic nonsuppurative otitis media
 - 382.1 Chronic *tubotympanic suppurative* otitis media
 - 382.2 Chronic atticoantral suppurative otitis media



Otitis Media – ICD-10

Diseases of middle ear and mastoid (H65-H75)

H65 Nonsuppurative otitis media

Includes: nonsuppurative otitis media with myringitis

Use additional code for any associated perforated tympanic membrane (H72.-)

Use additional code to identify:

exposure to environmental tobacco smoke (Z77.22)

exposure to tobacco smoke in the perinatal period (P96.81)

history of tobacco use (Z87.891)

occupational exposure to environmental tobacco smoke (Z57.31)

tobacco dependence (F17.-)

tobacco use (Z72.0)



Otitis Media – ICD-10

- Laterality: Left, right, bilateral,
 unspecified
- Occurrence: Recurrent, acute, chronic
- Types: Allergic (acute, subacute), serous, nonsuppurative, mucoid, sanguinous, seromucinous, tubotympanic, atticoantral
- Rupture:
 - Without
 - With: code for perforation too

Otitis Media - ICD-10

Otitis media in diseases classified elsewhere

Code first underlying disease, such as: viral disease NEC (B00-B34)

Use additional code for any associated perforated tympanic membrane (H72.-)

Excludes1: otitis media in:

influenza (J09.X9, J10.83, J11.83)

measles (B05.3)

scarlet fever (A38.0)

tuberculosis (A18.6)



January 2015 AAP Coding NL Highlights

- Revised ICD-10 guidelines 2015
 - Clarity on Initial vs. subsequent encounters
- ICD-10 concept: Late effects and sequelae
- Advice for using new "X series" of -59 modifiers



-59 Subset Modifiers

- Services are distinct because...:
 - XE ...it occurred during a separate encounter
 - XS ...it was performed on a separate organ/structure
 - XP ... it was performed by a different practitioner
 - XU ...it does not overlap usual components of the main service
