 - SNOMED to ICD-10 mapping (Read-only...so far)
 - ICD10 to ICD9 For claims
 - Immunization Forecasting in EHR
- V6.28 Deploys June 28th
 - Increased specificity of SNOMED selections
 - 3rd Party Interfaces

Eczema in ICD-10

Tabular - Chapter Guidance

Excludes2:

certain conditions originating in the perinatal period (P04-P96)

certain infectious and parasitic diseases (A00-B99)

complications of pregnancy, childbirth and the puerperium (O00-O9A)

congenital malformations, deformations, and chromosomal abnormalities (Q00-Q99)

endocrine, nutritional and metabolic diseases (E00-E88)



Eczema in ICD-10

Tabular - Chapter Guidance(cont'd)

Excludes 2 (cont'd):

lipomelanotic reticulosis (I89.8)

neoplasms (C00-D49)

symptoms, signs and abnormal clinical and laboratory findings, not elsewhere classified (R00-R94)

systemic connective tissue disorders (M30-M36)

viral warts (B07.-)



Eczema in ICD-10

Tabular - Section Guidance

Excludes2:

chronic (childhood) granulomatous disease (D71)

dermatitis gangrenosa (L08.0)

dermatitis herpetiformis (L13.0)

dry skin dermatitis (L85.3)

factitial dermatitis (L98.1)



Eczema in ICD-10

Tabular - Section Guidance(cont'd)

Excludes2 (cont'd):

perioral dermatitis (L71.0)

radiation-related disorders of the skin and subcutaneous tissue (L55-L59)

stasis dermatitis (I83.1-I83.2)

Excludes 2: circumscribed neurodermatitis (L28.0)

Body Mass Index - BMI

BMI – Z68._

- BMI adult codes are for use for persons 21 years of age or older
- BMI pediatric codes are for use for persons 2-20 years of age. These percentiles are based on the growthcharts published by the *Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)*

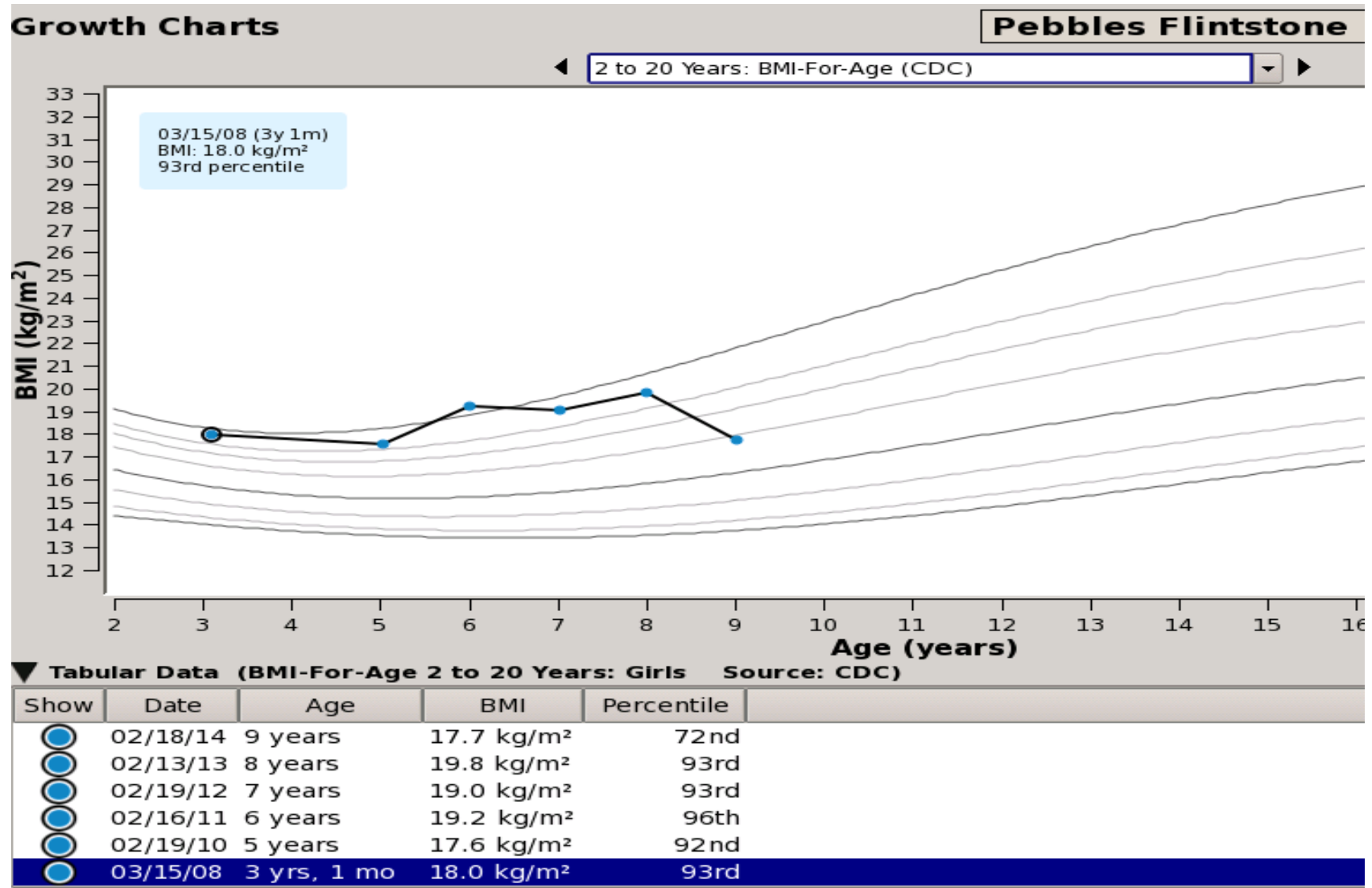
Pediatric BMI

Z68.5_ Body mass index (BMI) pediatric

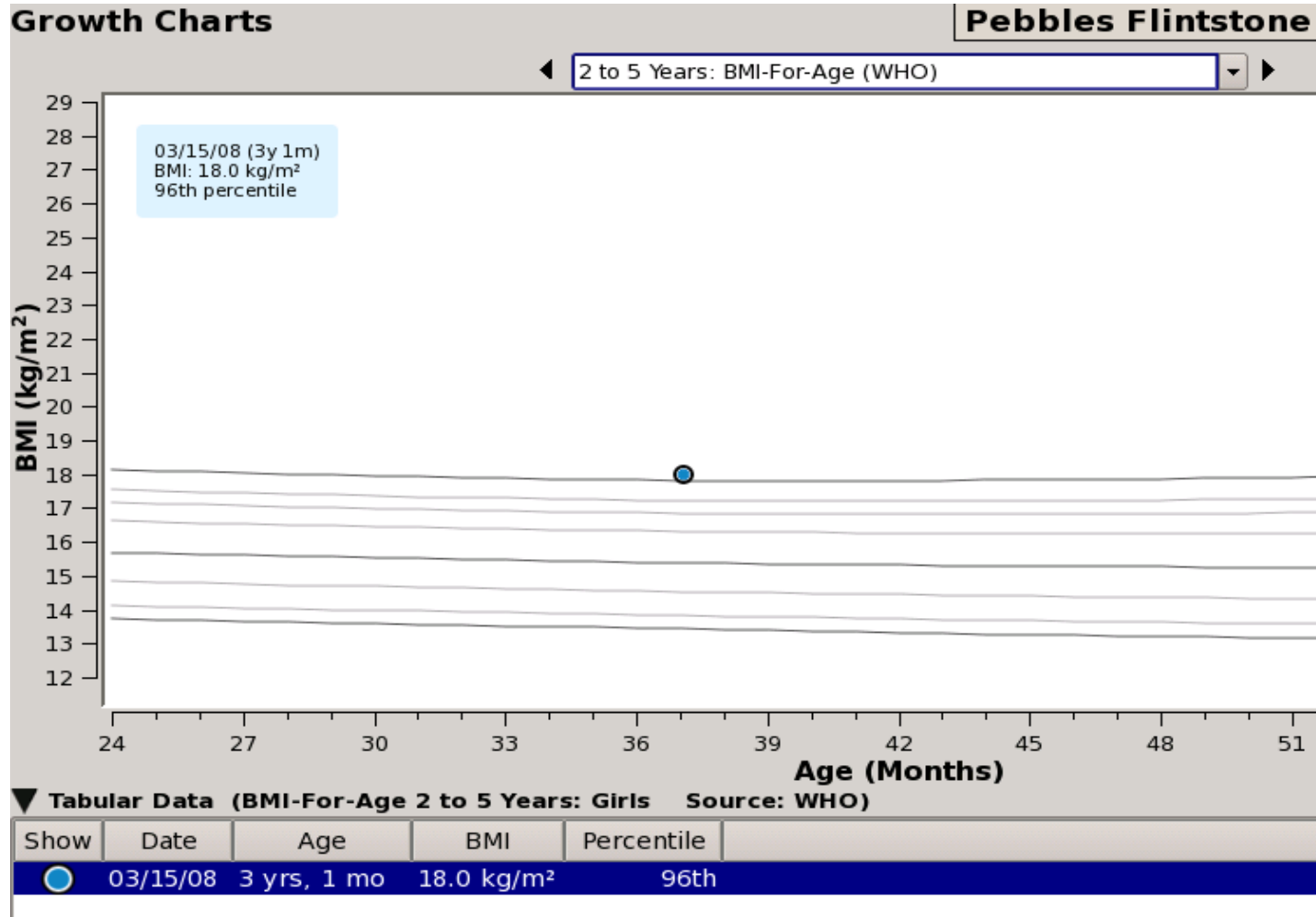
- Z68.51 ... less than 5th percentile for age
- Z68.52 ... less than 85th percentile for age
- Z68.53 ... less than 95th percentile for age
- Z68.54 ... greater than or equal to 95th percentile for age

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Dietary Counseling

Z71.3 Dietary counseling and surveillance

- Use additional code ...
 - ...for any associated underlying medical condition
 - ... to identify body mass index (BMI), if known (Z68.-)
