Nurse Practitioner 1:

Provider Role

- Together with MD/DOs review Newborn Screens, lead screens and labs.
- Act as resource to phone nurse for questions/concerns
- Daily assessment of urine and throat cultures
- Review nursing staff with Nurse Manager

On Call Role

- Returns after hours phone calls to all families
- Schedules and see patients in office after hours, when appropriate
- Refers families to ED when appropriate
- Contacts back up physician for all admissions, when medical advice is warranted, or if it too

busy to see all the patients alone

• Rounds on Newborns and convalescent inpatients on weekends

Nurse Practitioner 2:

Administrative Role

- Recruits and coordinates interview process for potential nursing role
- Checks references on Nurse Candidates

Provider Role

- Together with MD/DOs and NP's review Newborn Screens, Lead screens and Labs.
- Acts a resource to phone nurse for questions/concerns
- Daily assessment of urine culture and throat cultures
