87635 Infectious agent detection by nucleic acid (DNA or RNA); severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) (Coronavirus disease [COVID-19]), amplified probe technique

- 90689 Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (IIV4), inactivated, adjuvanted, preservative free, 0.25 mL dosage, for intramuscular use
- 90587 Dengue vaccine, quadrivalent, live, 3 dose schedule, for subcutaneous use
- 90694 Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (allV4), inactivated, adjuvanted, preservative free, 0.5 mL dosage, for intramuscular use
- 90619 MenACWY quadrivalent, tetanus toxoid carrier, for intramuscular use

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COVID-19 Billing and Coding

CMS announced "payment is available" for E&M codes for counseling for COVID testing. Must document discussion of:

- Need immediate isolation, even before results available
- Should inform immediate household/contacts that they may wish to be tested and quarantine as well. Review locations and people they have been in contact with in the past two weeks.
- Signs and symptoms of COVID-19
- If positive, they will likely be contacted by a public health worker and asked to provide a list of the people they've been with for contact tracing, encourage them to 'answer the call'.
- Discuss services that might help the patient successfully isolate and quarantine at home.




