Data Sources

Date Selections

- Transaction Date
 - Charges = Date of Service
 - Payments = User determines at time of posting
- Posting Date
 - Always matches the date on which the transaction is entered into the system



Data Sources

Reports

- Payments
 - Centers Payments and can include details linked to the payments selected
- Charges
 - Centers Charges and can include details linked to the charges selected
- Daysheet
 - Centers dates and can include the kitchen sink for the dates selected

Charge Reports

Can focus on:

Charge data with Collection details for *all charges*

or

Billing / submission information for *outstanding charges* (Yet to to be collected)

Charge Data

Charge Reports center elements specific to Charges, including things like:

- Amount Due
- Current Responsible Party
- Linked Diagnoses
- Place of Service
- Collection Information
 - Amount collected
 - Percent collected
- CPTs



Payment Data

Payment Reports center elements specific to Payments, including things like:

- Payment Amount
- Adjustment Amount
- Allowable Amount
- Linked charges
 - Insurance plan at the time the payment was posted



Daysheet

Daysheet Reports center elements specific to the dates the report is restricted to.

This can be restrictions to both the Posting date and the Transaction date





National Drug Code (NDC) Tips and Tricks

 For insurance billing / claims, the NDC is referenced from the PCC Practice Management Table EDitor (ted) Procedures Table:



- HIPAA requires the 5-4-2 NDC format
 - "0" is prefixed to the shorter labeler (4-4-2), product (5-3-2), or package (5-4-1) code segment as applicable
- The syringe / vial NDC aka the "Unit of Use" (UoU) code is generally appropriate for claim reporting
 - Distinct from the container packaging "Unit of Sale" (UoS) code
- Search the <u>FDA National Drug Code Directory</u>
