What Happened?

- Change Healthcare, part of Optum and UnitedHealth Group, is the largest clearinghouse for insurance billing and payments in the U.S.
- Change Healthcare systems suffered a ransomware attack on February 21st, were immediately taken offline, and many services remain inaccessible as of March 14th
- Electronic insurance eligibility verification, electronic claim submission, and electronic remittance advice processing have been effectively disabled as a result for numerous payors, notably those which have exclusive electronic data interchange (EDI) arrangements with Change Healthcare









What's Been Done?

- PCC's continued mitigation effort has ensured that currently 93% of the collective claims submitted through PCC systems are not directed to Change Healthcare
- The electronic claim transactions which remain affected are largely for payors which require provider re-enrollment for alternate routing and / or for which no alternate routing is yet available
- Electronic eligibility verification remains affected but mitigation effort is a lower priority than claim processing
- Roughly 28% of the collective Electronic remittance advice (ERA) which PCC receives and forwards to receiving PCC EHR systems remains affected









When Will This Be Resolved?

• As of March 14th, <u>UnitedHealth Group reports</u> the following:

Timeline to Restore Change Healthcare Systems

We are working aggressively on the restoration of our systems and services. Assuming we continue at our current rate of progress, we expect our key system functionality to be restored and available on the following timelines:

- Payments platform: Electronic payment functionality will be available for connection beginning March 15.
- Medical claims: We expect to begin testing and reestablish connectivity to our claims network and software on March 18, restoring service through that week.

Administrative Simplification Enforcement and Testing Tool

ASETT is a web-based application which enables individuals or organizations to file a Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and/or Affordable Care Act (ACA) complaint against a HIPAA covered entity for potential non-compliance with the non-Privacy/Security provisions of HIPAA.

Step 2: Provide your contact information

Step 3: Identify the Filed Against Entity

Step 4: Describe the HIPAA/ACA violation

Step 5: Review and Submit















