

- SNOMED: PCC Maintained
- ICD-10: PCC Maintained (ted #29)
- HCPCS: Practice Controlled (ted #6)
- CPT: Practice Controlled (ted #6)

LOINC Selection & Configuration

- Search and selection in lab configuration only
- Codes are built into EHR
- PCC updates with software releases
 - V8.9 included newest codes

International Health Terminology Standards Development Organisation (IHTSDO)/U. S. National Library of Medicine (NLM); Updated biannually (March, Sept)




Recommended PCC EHR Configuration for CMS2 Depression Screening

- SNOMED-CT procedure code 171207006, "Depression screening"
- LOINC test code 73831-0 Adolescent depression screening assessment" and/or

LOINC 73832-8, "Adult depression screening assessment" 18 yrs + up

ICD Selection - 2020 Preview

ALWAYS start at the index ...

Body, bodies

- Aschoff's -see Myocarditis, rheumatic
- asteroid, vitreous -see Deposit, crystalline
- mass index (BMI)
- - adult
- --- 19.9 or less Z68.1
- --- 20.0-20.9 Z68.20
- --- 21.0-21.9 Z68.21
- --- 60.0-69.9 Z68.44
- --- 70 and over Z68.45
- - pediatric
- --- 5th percentile to less than 85th percentile for age Z68.52
- --- 85th percentile to less than 95th percentile for age Z68.53
- - greater than or equal to ninety-fifth percentile for age Z68.54
- - less than fifth percentile for age Z68.51

...and **THEN** go to the Tabular

Body mass index [BMI] (Z68)

Z68 Body mass index [BMI]

Kilograms per meters squared

Note: BMI adult codes are for use for persons 20 years of age or older.

BMI pediatric codes are for use for persons 2-19 years of age.

HCPCS

Translation:

Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System

Source:

CMS' Alpha-Numeric Editorial Panel; Updated quarterly (Jan, April, July, Oct)

<u>Use</u>:

"Identify products, supplies, and services not included in the CPT codes, such as ambulance services and durable medical equipment, prosthetics, orthotics, and supplies (DMEPOS)"




HCPCS Selection

- Often recommended by vendors selling the supplies, equipment
- Reported as claim data so managed, updated, mapped, billed like CPTs
- Considerations:
 - Dosage
 - Drug formulations (Liquid, tablet, aerosol, etc)
 - Delivery method (oral, IM, IV, etc)

Source:

American Medical Association (AMA); Updated: Annually, eff Jan 1

<u>Use</u>:

Describes the services rendered; office visits (E&M, Well care), procedures, labs, tests, etc











Refine your search











Is the patient's age a factor? Their weight? Examples:

- 94011 Measurement of spirometric forced expiratory flows in an infant or child through 2 years of age
- 94012 Measurement of spirometric forced expiratory flows, before and after bronchodilator, in an infant or child through 2 years of age

Modifier -63 Procedure performed on Infants less than 4 kg





Who rendered the service? Phone Care example:

 99441-99443 Physician (MD, DO) or *Other* Qualified Healthcare Professional (QHCP)

VS.

 98966-98968 for Qualified Nonphysicians who may not report evaluation and management services [eg, speech-language pathologists, physical therapists, occupational therapists, social workers, dietitians





Where was the service rendered?

- Inpatient
- Outpatient
- Home, domiciliary





Typical Durations exist for many services including

E&M, counseling, telephone care. Example: E&M

99201 - 10 minutes

99202 - 20 minutes

99203 - 30 minutes

99204 - 45 minutes

99205 - 60 minutes

99211 - 5 minutes*

99212 - 10 minutes

99213 - 15 minutes

99214 - 25 minutes

99215 - 40 minutes

*NOT for MD/DO/NP/PA time





Remember the Midpoint Rule

OR Leveling may be based upon time: Greater than 50% of face-to-face time must be explicitly stated to have been spent in counseling and discussion (Include discussion topics)

Approach - Open vs. closed, instruments, venous vs. arterial, e.g. Example:

- 69210 Removal impacted cerumen requiring instrumentation, unilateral
- 69209 Removal impacted cerumen using irrigation/lavage, unilateral





CPT Modifiers

- 22 Increased Procedural Service
- 50 Bilateral Procedure
- 53 Discontinued Procedure
- 57 Decision for Surgery
- 59 Distinct Procedural Service





CPT Modifiers

- 63 Procedure performed on Infants less than 4kg
- 76 Repeat Procedure or Service by Same Physician or QHCP
- 91 Repeat Clinical Diagnostic Laboratory Test
- 95 Synchronous Telemedicine Services Rendered Via a
- Real-Time Interactive Audio and Video Telecom System
- 99 Multiple Modifiers





CPT II Codes

Used for performance measurement. Example:


- 4132F Use this code for patients diagnosed with Acute Otitis
 Externa who were *not* prescribed Systemic antimicrobial therapy.
- **4131F** Use this code for patients diagnosed with Acute Otitis Externa who were prescribed Systemic antimicrobial therapy.
