ICD-10 Roadmap

- ICD-10 to SNOMED smarts in place by April 2015 (v6.28)
- Some carriers actively looking for endto-end testers
 - CMS hand picking clearinghouses only
 - United Health completed selection of a limited number of provider testers
 - Researching Mass Health now

- ICD-9
 - 599.0 Urinary tract infection, site not specified



UTI - ICD-10 (Index)

- umbilicus L08.82
- ureter N28.86
- urethra —see Urethritis
- urinary (tract) N39.0
- - bladder —see Cystitis
- complicating
- - pregnancy O23.4-
- - specified type NEC O23.3-
- - kidney —see Infection, kidney
- - newborn P39.3
- puerperal (postpartum) O86.20
- tuberculous A18.13
- - urethra —see Urethritis
- uterus, uterine -see Endometritis
- vaccination T88.0
- vaccinia not from vaccination B08.011
- vagina (acute) see Vaginitis



UTI – ICD-10 (Tabular)

tuberculosis (A18.13)

N39 Other disorders of urinary system

Excludes2: hematuria NOS (R31.-)
recurrent or persistent hematuria (N02.-)
recurrent or persistent hematuria with specified morphological lesion (N0 proteinuria NOS (R80.-)

N39.0 Urinary tract infection, site not specified

Use additional code (B95-B97), to identify infectious agent.

Excludes1: candidiasis of urinary tract (B37.4-)
neonatal urinary tract infection (P39.3)
urinary tract infection of specified site, such as:
cystitis (N30.-)
urethritis (N34.-)

N39.3 Stress incontinence (female) (male)

Code also any associated overactive bladder (N32.81)

Excludes1: mixed incontinence (N39.46)

CPT Updates eff 1/1/15

- Vaccines
- E&M
- Care Management



Pending FDA Approval

- 90630 IIV4 Flu, Preservative free
- 90651 HPV 9 (nonvalent), 3 dose IM



Vaccine Edits

- 90654 now Influenza trivalent
- 90721 & 90723 "T" Capitalized in DTaP
- 90734 Meningococcal became quadrivalent (*was* tetravalent)



Evaluation & Management

- Pediatric Critical Care
 - Transport
 - Inpatient Neonates, Critical and Intensive Care



Care Management

- Chronic Care Management
 - 99490 Chronic Care Services
 - 20" minimum for the month
 - At least two chronic problems
 - Expected to last at least 1 yr
 - Significant risk



Complex Care Management

- 99487 60" & 99489 +30"
 - Chronic Care requirements plus moderate to high MDM
 - 60 minutes of time
 - 30" increments thereafter
 - 99488 deleted

New EHR Features

- v6.25 released 11/9/14
- V6.26 expected 1/25/15



Migration

 More disease-specific encounters give you more specific tools to customize
