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# ICD-10 Roadmap

- Releases on track for
  - v6.29 – 9/13/15
  - V7.0 – 9/27/15
    - Fully certified for ARRA Meaningful Use using the 2014 Edition standards

Practices using PCC EHR who need 90-day reporting window in 2015 to apply for Meaningful Use or PCMH Recognition in 2015 will need the 7.0 release

- Only 21 States are adopting ICD-10 for Worker's Compensation

# ICD-10 News

- Medicaid providers who will NOT be ready on 10/1/15:
  - California
  - Maryland
  - Louisiana
  - Montana
- Will they accept ICD-9s?
  - If yes: Map your ICD-10s to ICD-9  
(Table#29)



# ICD-10 End-to-end Testing

- Medicaid of Massachusetts and Medicaid of North Carolina
  - Testing was successful and has concluded.
- UnitedHealth
  - In progress. Neutrality review underway. Results next week.
- Texas Medicaid Health Partnership
  - Suspended. Have concluded their testing and will not accept our submission.





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  - Medicare claims ONLY

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# “Abnormal Findings” Response from AAP

- Q. When is it appropriate to report the health exam for child with abnormal findings code (Z00.121)?
  - A. There is no official guidance within Coding Clinic (the official supplement to ICD-10-CM), however we are asking for this to be addressed. (Nov meeting)



# AAP Pediatric Superbill

- Now with variables!!
  - Name
  - DOB
  - Sex
  - Appointment date



# SNOMED Mapping

- Some SNOMEDs more detailed than ICD-10
  - Some ICD-10s may require two SNOMEDs to express the concept(s)
    - Moderate, persistent asthma, Well with abnormal findings
- Some SNOMEDs express ranges which are out of line w/ICD-10
  - Prematurity



# SNOMED Mapping

- Reverse engineer to find good matches.  
Search on:
  - Clinical term
  - Familiar ICD-9
  - ICD-10 goal



# SNOMED Mapping

- Map to most used ICD-10
  - Add lesser used ICD-10s to Electronic Encounter Form but, BEWARE Contradictions across note and billing record
- Make plan to revisit EEF configuration after some use/once some ICD-10 data is available
