

Noteworthy Revisions

- Entropian became Entropion
- Specificity and plurality added to:
 - Embolisms
 - Varicose veins
- Postinfective urethral strictures
 - Specified as male
- Extrophy became Exstrophy





Noteworthy Revisions

- Right eye became right side (optic tract and visual cortex)
 • Finger and toe fractures:
 • Medial to middle

- Subluxation of unspecified interphalangeal ioint of thumb
- Powered powered hand tools became powered hand tools

Coding Question #1

"Dr saw a patient in the hospital and spent 90 mins. The cpt for subsequent visit 99233 is for 35 minutes. How do I bill the additional time spent?"





Coding Answer #1

99356 Prolonged service in the *inpatient* setting or observation setting, requiring unit/floor time beyond the usual service; first hour

+99357 Prolonged service in the *inpatient or* observation setting, requiring unit/floor time beyond the usual service; each additional 30 minutes (List separately in addition to code for prolonged physician service)
