Third Party EDI Outages and System Status

- The major EDI clearinghouses (Availity, Change Healthcare, Optum,
 etc) are interconnected and rely on one another
 - Some have exclusive payor contracts / rights
- Service outages and unscheduled downtime happen regularly, notably affecting real-time service (e. g. eligibility verification)
- Some clearinghouses now present publicly accessible systems status
 - Availity Network Outage Notification
 - Change Healthcare System Status
 - PCC refers to such resources to help ensure successful EDI



Cigna Delays Modifier 25 Policy for (E/M) with Minor Procedure

After AAP, other organizations protest, Cigna changes course on modifier 25 policy

Cigna will delay requiring additional documentation to support the use of modifier 25 when billed with evaluation and management (E/M) Current Procedural Terminology codes 99212-99215 and a minor procedure. The delay follows opposition to the new requirement by the AAP and more than 100 other physician and health care organizations.

This is the second time Cigna has delayed requiring the submission of office notes for E/M services reported with modifier 25. Cigna changed course after the American Medical Association, with support from the AAP and other groups, urged the insurance company to "reconsider this policy due to its negative impact on practice administrative costs."

Cigna stated that it "will continue to review for future implementation."

Bivalent COVID-19 Vaccine Administration

Addition of More Bivalent COVID-19 Administration Codes: In late April, the FDA removed EUA for monovalent COVID-19 vaccines and expanded authorization for bivalent vaccines. This resulted in new administration billing codes (0171A, 0172A, 0151A, 0121A, 0141A, 0142A). These codes are retroactively available to April 18th, 2023. PCC updated your practice's claim validation lists for the new codes.
