

What is pocketPCC?

- A web/mobile interface to PCC EHR accessible via browser or mobile devices.
- Ideal for clinicians & staff on the move—no app downloads required.



PCC on the go. This is the way.



Benefits of pocketPCC


- Mobility: Chart and prescribe anytime, anywhere
- Efficiency: Quick workflows without desktop
- Security: Device verification + session control
- Continuous Innovation: Regular updates in PCC releases





Getting Started with pocketPCC

- Access via practice-specific URL (e.g., https://ACRO.pcc.com/pocketpcc)
- Users need proper role permissions & a security question set.
- Supports bookmarking or adding to home screen for quick access.







Security & Session Management

- First-time devices require answering a security question; re-prompt every two months.
- Supports session timeout configuration via practice preferences.
- Note: Private/incognito browsing resets device trust—security question required each session










Navigation & Patient Charts

- View your daily schedule and easily search for patients.
- Access Medical Summary, Demographics, Immunizations, Visit History, and Documents.
- Seamless toggling between patient chart sections with intuitive menu structure.









Core Clinical Features

I am frozen to my core.

Prescriptions (eRx):

- Create new prescriptions, renew/refill, manage Rx Queue
- Edit pharmacies, review med history/allergies; EPCS requires a physical hard token.
- Some advanced eRx capabilities (e.g., pharmacy responses, soft tokens, logs) remain exclusive to full PCC EHR.

Phone Notes & Tasks: Easily document and manage phone calls.

Portal Messages: Read and reply to patient portal messages.

Vitals & Files: Enter/edit vitals; upload photos or files to patient chart on-the-fly.

Signing Documents: Sign visits, phone notes, documents directly within pocketPCC.





